



Requirements for R.J. Reynolds High School Sports Hall of Fame

The R.J. Reynolds High School Sports Hall of Fame recognizes outstanding individuals associated with R.J. Reynolds High School athletics who have graduated or have been associated with athletics at the school, and who have been selected for their contributions while they attended or were associated with the school.

Players

To be eligible, a candidate must have graduated from R.J. Reynolds High School at least seven (7) years prior to nomination. They must have received athletic recognition while at Reynolds, including, but not limited to All Conference, All State, or other sports-related honors recognized by the school. Finally, players nominated for consideration must have displayed outstanding character as an athlete at Reynolds and as a citizen in the community.

Coaches

To be eligible, candidates must have shown excellent skills in coaching their athletic team. They must have served as head coach of a varsity sport for a minimum of seven (7) years and should have coached at least one conference/district or state championship team. Candidates must have made outstanding contributions to the school and must have displayed outstanding character as a coach and as a citizen.

Note: Coaches currently on staff at Reynolds who meet the above criteria are eligible for consideration.

Administrators

To be eligible, principals and athletic directors* must have served for a minimum of seven (7) years and must have made significant contributions to the Reynolds school community, including programs which complement the academic goals of Reynolds High School.

**In addition to the above, an athletic director nominee must have shown competent financial responsibility in running his/her athletic department.*

Special Category

To nominate someone for consideration outside of the above categories (such as support staff, media personnel, etc.), criteria should include significant service to the R.J. Reynolds community through the development of student athletes and to the athletic programs. Finally, as in the above categories, any person nominated for consideration must have made outstanding contributions to the school and must have displayed outstanding character while associated with R.J. Reynolds High School and as a community citizen.

Notes: Once there is a nomination, candidates will be considered for induction annually. There is no need for re-nomination.

The Hall of Fame committee will select each year deserving inductees from the submitted nominations. The Hall of Fame inductees will be invited by R.J. Reynolds High School and may participate, in person, in recognition activities in the spring. Each inductee name will also be engraved on a plaque placed in the school.

To nominate an RJR graduate or other person for the Hall of Fame consideration, the nominator must complete the following form and return it by **March 1, 2009**, to the RJR Booster Club at the school office or mail to: RJR Booster Club, 301 N.
