NAACP (Lewis-Marsh-Corporate) Scholarships. Criteria: graduating high school senior, minimum unweighted 2.5 GPA, pursuit of 2yr/4yr degree, youth-member of WS branch of NAACP. Application packets available in Student Services scholarship crate. Deadline to sponsor is **April 10, 2008.**

******SECU Foundation "People Helping People" Scholarship.** Criteria: graduating senior attending one of the 16 UNC System universities, minimum 2.5 GPA, US citizen and NC resident, demonstrated leadership, character, integrity, community involvement, preference given to dependents of public sector employees who live and work in NC. **School Endorsement Required (1).** Submit typed senior resume, acceptance letter and typed scholarship interest form to Mr. Felder no later than **April 11, 2008.******
